MEMORANDUM.

In the case of Imports the values given represent the values of commodities, landed in Bangkok. They do not include the amount of duty. In the case of Exports the values represent the cost of the goods, including all charges thereon up to the time of their delivery on board ship; they thus include the duty.

The quantities and values of both Imports and Exports are given whenever possible. But in the case of Imports liable to an ad valorem duty great difficulty is experienced in obtaining quantities. Even those given must be accepted with caution. More reliance may be placed on the values, which are subject to check at the hands of the Department's Officers. In the case of Exports, on the other hand, where the duty is leviable on quantities, the difficulty is to obtain proper values. Deductions can in such cases be more accurately drawn from a comparison of quantities. This is particularly so in the case of Rice.

Imports are credited to their original countries of consignment whenever possible, but large quantities of goods are, of necessity, credited to Singapore and Hongkong for want of further information. In the same way many goods are shewn as exported to Singapore and Hongkong which are obviously intended for transhipment, but the ultimate destination of which cannot be ascertained.

APPENDIX.

The tables appended represent an attempt to show the development of the trade of the Port of Bangkok from the year 1892, when official statistics were first collected, down to the present time. Of the records now in existence, those for the years 1892 to 1901 have for their unit the old Straits dollar, the value of which ranged, during those years, from $2/10\frac{1}{2}$ to $1/11\frac{9}{16}$. The unit used from 1892 onwards has been the tical, the value of which has varied from £1=Ticals 19.84 to £1=Ticals 13.08. To provide a basis of comparison the figures in the following tables have been converted into pounds sterling.

Allowance has also been made for the over-declaration of the value of teak, to which reference was made in the memoranda attached to the reports issued for the years R. S. 128 and 129. Reductions have been made in the total value of teak squares and teak scantlings exported to India and Ceylon during the six years R. S. 122 to 127. The corrected figures are based partly on comparisons made with figures collected under the new system introduced in April 1910, and partly on inquiries made directly of merchants concerned.

All totals are shown both in tabular and in graphic form.

together with rate of exchange.




