Your Highness,

I have the honour to submit a Statement of the Foreign Trade and Navigation of the Port of Bangkok for the Siamese year 126 (April 1st, 1907 to March 31st. 1908). Previous statements of this nature, presented annually since 1899, have covered periods corresponding to the Christian year (January 1st. to December 31st), and the change of period to that of the Siamese year (April 1st. to March 31st), left a hiatus of three months—January to March 1907. To meet this difficulty the detailed figures for the two Siamese years, 125 (April 1906 to March 1907) and 126 (April 1907 to March 1908) have been printed side by side; so that comparison between the figures for the year 125 (April 1906 to March 1907) and the figures already published for the Christian year 1906, may at once reveal any increase or decrease in the three months January to March 1907, as compared with the three months January to March 1906.

In preparing the Comparative Tables it has been found possible to tabulate all the figures in Siamese years, with the exception of those of tables V and VI—Total Value of Imports and Exports from and to each Country; so that the Comparative Tables already published, shewing the figures of Christian years, have been practically superseded.

MEMORANDUM.

In the case of Imports the Values are intended to represent the cost, plus insurance and freight to the place of landing. The values are exclusive of the amount of duty. In the case of Exports the values are intended to represent the cost of the goods, including all charges thereon up to the time of their delivery on board ship : they thus include the duty.

The quantities and value of both Imports and Exports have been given whenever possible. But in the case of Imports liable to an ad valorem duty the greatest difficulty has been experienced in obtaining quantities ; even those given must be accepted with caution. More reliance may be placed on the values, which are subject to check at the hands of the Department's Officers. In the case of Exports, on the other hand, where the duty is leviable on quantities, the difficulty has been in obtaining proper values. Deductions can in such cases be more accurately drawn from a comparison of quantities. This is particularly so in the case of Rice. In the case of Teak the Department depends, both for quantities and values, on information supplied by the merchants concerned. The figures must be treated as approximations only.

Imports have been credited to their original countries of consignment whenever possible, but large quantities of goods have, of necessity, been credited to Singapore and Hong Kong for want of further information. In the same way many goods are shewn as exported to Singapore and Hong Kong which are obviously intended for transhipment, but the ultimate destination of which cannot be ascertained. There are also certain consignments of both Teak and Rice of which nothing further is known than that they are shipped to Europe, or the Azores "For Orders."
