MEMORANDUM.

In the case of Imports the values given represent the values of commodities, landed in Bangkok. They do not include the amount of duty. In the case of Exports the values represent the cost of the goods, including all charges thereon up to the time of their delivery on board ship : they thus include the duty.

The quantities and values of both Imports and Exports have been given whenever possible. But in the case of Imports liable to an ad valorem duty the greatest difficulty has been experienced in obtaining quantities ; even those given must be accepted with caution. More reliance may be placed on the values, which are subject to check at the hands of the Department's Officers. In the case of Exports, on the other hand, where the duty is leviable on quantities, the difficulty has been in obtaining proper values. Deductions can in such cases be more accurately drawn from a comparison of quantities. This is particularly so in the case of Rice.

In the memoranda attached to previous reports, reference has been made to the possible unreliability of the figures representing the value of Teak exported. A new system of collecting these figures comes into force from April 1st, 1910, by means of which it is hoped to secure, if not absolute accuracy, at least a close and trustworthy approximation. Next year an attempt will be made to examine previous figures in the light of this more accurate information. In the meanwhile the Department has felt justified in attempting a revised estimate of the value of teak exported during last year. The values now given are calculated on the basis of information obtained as the result of a recent enquiry, and the official figures, as collected under the old system, have been entirely rejected. The most noteworthy change is in the figures representing the value of Teak exported to India, where the reduction is large enough to affect materially not only the total of teak exports, but the total of all exports to India, and even the balance as between the grand total of Imports and Exports. In making comparisons of all these figures, a generous allowance must be made on the supposition of over declaration in previous years.

Imports have been credited to their original countries of consignment whenever possible, but large quantities of goods have, of necessity, been credited to Singapore and Hongkong for want of further information. In the same way many goods are shewn as exported to Singapore and Hongkong which are obviously intended for transhipment, but the ultimate destination of which cannot be ascertained. There are also certain consignments of goods, particularly of rice, of which nothing further is known than that they are shipped to Europe.
